What is CHOICES?

Connecticut's Health Insurance Assistance Outreach, Information and Referral, Counseling, and Eligibility Screening.

CHOICES Counselors provide counseling, education, and advocacy training to Medicare beneficiaries of all ages.

The five-day CHOICES Training includes an overview of:

- Medicare Parts A, B, C, & D
- Medigap (supplemental insurance)
- Medicaid (Title 19)
- Medicare Savings Programs
- ConnPace
- Medicare Advantage Plans
- Long-Term Care Insurance
- Medicare/Medicaid Fraud abuse detection and prevention.

Who should take the CHOICES Training?

Individuals who would like to assist Medicare beneficiaries, family members, and aging network professionals to understand the various options, benefits, and services available.

What are CHOICES Training Requirements?

You must attend all five training sessions in order to receive your CHOICES certification. Upon completion of the training, you will be expected to keep current on the topics that affect Medicare beneficiaries by attending the update trainings and reading all e-mail updates. Reporting on individual counseling sessions and community update trainings you have provided is required as well. The reporting is done on a monthly basis.

How much does the CHOICES Training Cost?

The training is free for unpaid volunteers, retired, or non-employed professionals. A \$125 fee is required for professionals.
